



ARKANSAS STATE POSTGAME NOTES
CAMELLIA BOWL
vs. Middle Tennessee (Dec. 16, 2017)

TEAM

- A-State's team captains were seniors **Blake Mack, Blaise Taylor, Dijon Paschal, Caleb Caston** and **Johnston White**.

OFFENSE

- Junior QB **Justice Hansen** recorded his team-leading seventh rushing TD of the season, and added three more through the air to give him 44 touchdowns responsible for . . . Hansen has now thrown at least one TD pass in 17 consecutive games . . . He has thrown multiple TD passes in a game 13 of his last 14 outings . . . He ended the season with 37 TD passes, giving him 56 for his career . . . Hansen broke both the school and Sun Belt Conference records for total offense in a season . . . He also became the fourth player in school history to record 7,000 yards total offense in a career.
- Junior WR **Justin McInnis** posted his second career 100-yard receiving game – both have come over the Red Wolves' last three outings.
- Junior RB **Warren Wand** recorded his first receiving TD of the season and fourth of his career.
- With 358 passing yards tonight, the Red Wolves pushed their total on the year to 4,106 to break the single-season school record.
- Senior WR **Christian Booker** hauled in his sixth TD reception of the season.
- A-State ended its 2017 campaign with the highest total offense average per game in school history (494.75).
- Arkansas State posted at least 300 yards total offense for the 91st time over its last 102 games, including all but 5 contests under HC **Blake Anderson**.
- The Red Wolves went over 400 yards total offense for the 33rd time over its last 51 games. A-State posted at least 400 yards in 10 of its 12 games this season.

DEFENSE

- A-State recorded at least one turnover gained for the 43rd time in 51 games under defensive coordinator **Joe Cauthen**.
- Sophomore LB/DB **Darreon Jackson** recorded a career-high 12 tackles, including his first sack this season.
- Sophomore safety **B.J. Edmonds** recorded a career-high two interceptions, giving him three on the season . . . He is the second A-State player this year to post multiple interceptions in a game, joining Kyle Martin (2 vs. ULM).
- Junior DB **Justin Clifton** recorded his first interception this season and the fourth of his career.
- A-State posted multiple interceptions in a game for the fifth time this season and ends the year with 14 total INT's.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Sophomore punter **Cody Grace** recorded a career-long 61-yard punt . . . Including tonight, Grace posted at least one punt inside the opponent's 20-yard line every game played this season.
- Sophomore kicker **Sawyer Williams** made his only field goal attempt, improving to 16-of-22 on the season and 17-of-23 for his career . . . He ends the season with 93 points by kicking that are the fourth most in school history for a single season . . . His 16 field goals made are the sixth most in school history.
